SCOPING OPINION: PROPOSED SECTION 36: BACHAN BURN WIND FARM - NEAR DUNOON

The Argyll District Salmon Fishery Board is content that fisheries issues will be adequately addressed in the EIA. The Argyll Fisheries Trust has conducted fisheries surveys in the proposed development area, and the Argyll DSFB is satisfied as to the scope and quality of the surveys.

The remaining main issue we look forward to seeing in the EIA is the location and design of all stream crossings, as poorly designed stream crossings have the potential to have the greatest impact on fish and fish habitats in a wind farm development.
